Lupus is an acute chronic autoimmune disease which attacks any organ of the body in unpredictable ways. Diagnosis is difficult because symptoms vary between patients and can come and go. Delay in diagnosis can lead to permanent organ damage and sometimes death. If you think you may have lupus, ask your doctor for an ANA test. **THE LUPUS SOCIETY WANTS TO HELP**

- Achy joints
- Frequent fevers > 100 F.
- Arthritis (swollen joints)
- Prolonged or extreme fatigue
- Skin rashes
- Anemia
- Kidney involvement
- Chest pain in deep breathing
- Sun or light sensitivity
- Hair loss
- Blood clotting problems
- White or blue fingers when cold
- Seizures
- Mouth or nose sores
- Butterfly-shaped rash across the cheek and nose
